SPECIFIC ACTIVITIES

To reach this vision and goals a number of specific areas of attention for specific activities have been selected to unite and support the cleantech companies. The activities must both meet the needs which entrepre-

neurs and SMEs have, but also the needs of large international companies. In the initiative five areas of attention have been identified. These are:

Knowledge – providing intelligence on cleantech actors and networks, surveillance of legislation, support programs, possibilities for test- and demonstration programs nationally and abroad, lobbying and informative newsletters.

Test & Demonstration – providing access to state-of-the-art facilities, specialized incubation environments with close connection to universities, heading up demonstration facilities and access to public and private partnerships.

Matchmaking – facilitating matchmaking between projects, providing a platform knowledge sharing between the different actors in the cleantech sector and hosting visits to and from the region, for cleantech-actors to foster partnerships.

Innovation & Entrepreneurship – providing consulting and training for spin-out companies, projects to ensure a well connected flow of innovation from gap-funding of university projects to training and incubation, establishing new university courses within cleantech, scholarships and PhD

projects as well as a dedicated effort to attract foreign talent.

Visibility – developing a shared identity/brand for cleantech companies in Denmark, including shared marketing tools, local/international marketing of participating companies in the form of website exposure, as well as in marketing material. Establishing collaboration and exchange with world leading cleantech clusters and participation in international forums and conferences.

A unique set of actors unites behind Copenhagen Cleantech Cluster - including Copenhagen Capacity, Scion DTU, Confederation of Danish Industries (DI), Risø DTU and the University of Copenhagen as well as a number of municipalities and companies like Dong Energy, Vestas, Haldor Topsøe, Novozymes, Siemens and Better Place. The broad foundation of partners will ensure that the initiative embraces the entire value chain to benefit cleantech companies, researchers and entrepreneurs in Denmark.
